Access to high quality child care leads to a more skilled workforce, as school readiness leads to higher school performance, leading to higher high school and college graduation rates, and resulting in career-ready adults. The investment in early learning and development lays the foundation for tomorrow's workforce.

QQ to Our Families

A family's access to care is critical to their success. Parents are increasingly reliant upon child care to allow them to work, be productive members of their communities, and to support their families. The decision for many parents to work or continue their education depends on the availability and accessibility of affordable, quality child care.



Many children of working parents spend a majority of their waking hours in child care. Parents depend on quality child care to ensure their children's safety and to support their child's early learning. Quality early childhood experiences are essential to the healthy development of communication, critical thinking and decision making skills as adults.

Currently, the annual cost of child care in Virginia is 45% of a single parent's income for one child.

The child care industry employs 40,559 people and creates another 13,246 jobs in other sectors, for 53,805 jobs throughout Virginia.
