

# Infant and Toddler Endorsement Application Packet



#### **About the Infant and Toddler Endorsement Program (ITEP)**

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) offers the Infant and Toddler Endorsement Program (ITEP); originally developed by the Virginia Department of Social Services to meet the need for a highly qualified early childhood workforce. This program is designed to provide a comprehensive foundation of knowledge for working with infants and toddlers. The ITEP is a collaboration between the VDOE, the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), the Community College Workforce Alliance (CCWA), the Virginia Infant & Toddler Specialist Network (VA ITSN) and Child Care Aware of Virginia (CCAofVA).

VDOE Infant and Toddler Endorsement can be valuable as:

- o an entry-level credential for employment in the field of early childhood
- o a demonstration of foundation of knowledge working with infants and toddlers
- a supplement to a child-related degree or credential that does not include instruction on infants and toddlers
- o a supplement to a degree or credential outside the field of early childhood

Successful completion of courses can also fulfill requirements for annual licensing training hours and training that can be applied to a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential.

Participants have **two options** to receive an Infant and Toddler Endorsement.

#### Option 1 – VDOE Sponsored Classes

For this option, participants will complete 12 courses\* for infant and toddler care and education through the Virginia Infant & Toddler Specialist Network and complete an independent study packet for each course to demonstrate the application of content in an early care and education environment or learning environment setting.

- Participants will contact the Virginia Infant and Toddler Specialist Network for a course schedule;
- 2. successfully complete the course with a passing grade of 70% or higher;
- 3. complete the independent study packet (for each course);
- submit the certificate of completion for the course, completed independent study packet and the completed Infant and Toddler Program Application Form for Option 1 to Child Care Aware of Virginia by mail or email;

#### Option 2 - CDH 166 College Course

For this option, participants will complete one community college course.

- 1. Participants will enroll in a CHD 166 Infant and Toddler Programs course at a Virginia community college;
- 2. successfully complete this course with a passing grade of 70% or higher;
- submit the transcript for the course or a letter from the instructor that verifies completion of the course and the completed Infant and Toddler Program Application Form for Option 2 to Child Care Aware of Virginia by mail or email;
- Child Care Aware of Virginia will process and issue the Endorsement.

You may submit materials for one class at a time or all the materials at one time.

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#### Important reminder:

Make a copy of <u>all</u> materials for your own records BEFORE submitting to Child Care Aware of Virginia.

**Note:** Two of these courses (Child Abuse and Neglect: Recognition and Reporting and Health Screening for Child Care Professionals) are also available online through the Community College Workforce Alliance.

These courses are free to those working in a Virginia early child care and education program.
